Guest of honour **Justin Langer, Captain of Somerset C.C.C. and former Australian Test cricketer** has kindly agreed to talk about his past experience of international cricket, his views on the future of the game and the prospects for the forthcoming Ashes series. The evening is the first event in a series that the club will be holding to raise funds for a new pavilion at our home in the grounds of Killerton House. A Wisden Cricketer of the Year in 2001, Justin first played for Australia in 1993 and scored 7,676 runs in 105 Test Matches before he retired from international cricket, after helping Australia regain the Ashes in 2007. As captain of Somerset County Cricket Club, he has shown that he still has much to offer the game of cricket, scoring 1,000 first class runs in both 2007 and 2008 and leading the county to promotion to Division 1 of the County Championship in 2007 where they finished fourth in 2008.

The idyllic setting of the Killerton House estate has hosted cricket for over a century and it is now home to our new and thriving colts section. The Devon Women's Cricket Youth teams and the Pinhoe Spartans U10's football club also make use of our ground, so we have an ever increasing need to get the facilities up to a higher standard for all to enjoy.

The Club has gained planning consent for the new pavilion and it is now our task to raise the necessary funding to complete this vital project.
